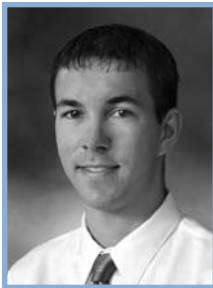
Matthew Sheehy, PTA
